Preliminary Qualifier Rules

Vocal:

1. Only 10 participants are eligible from each Waterloo Region Secondary school.
2. Competitors must sing acapella or to track, no background singers to accompany live.
3. Competitors may have their own dancers in the performance if they wish.
4. Background music must be on CD format only. No wave files, MP3, cassette, etc.
5. Song and title must be labelled on the CD, which must be presented at the Preliminary Qualifier and the Finals.
6. Entry forms, along with Waiver, must be signed by legal guardians if under 18 years of age.
7. Competitors are not allowed to speak to the judges before the competitions and can be disqualified if they attempt to do so.
8. Valid Student ID must be presented upon signing in during the Preliminary Qualifier.
9. Each participant will be allowed 1:30 (90 seconds) to perform their song. Any music beyond the allotted time will be cut off.
10. Preliminary auditions will be closed auditions and competitors will not be permitted to attend other competitors' auditions. Competitors will be required to wait in a separate area.

Hip Hop/Breakdance:

1. Only 5 solo participants are eligible from each Waterloo Region Secondary school.
2. Each participant will be allowed 1:30 (90 seconds) to perform. Any music beyond the allotted time will be cut off.
3. Background music must be on CD format only. CD must be clearly marked identifying the appropriate track. IF USING MORE THAN ONE TRACK, THEY MUST BE BURNED ON ONE COPY. Auditions will not be stopped to change over CDs for the performer.
4. Song and title must be labelled on the CD, which must be presented at the Preliminary Qualifier and the Finals.
5. Entry forms, along with Waiver, must be signed by legal guardians if under 18 years of age.
6. Competitors are not allowed to speak to the judges before the competitions and can be disqualified if they attempt to do so.
7. Valid Student ID must be presented upon signing in during the Preliminary Qualifier.
8. Preliminary auditions will be closed auditions and competitors will not be permitted to attend other competitors' auditions. Competitors will be required to wait in a separate area.
